- D36 Bar codes scoring
- Bring your helmet to sign ups.
- Background & Assigned Number Required on All 3 plates
- Motorcycle MUST pass California State Technical Inspection (including sound test (96dB), spark arrestor, and green/red sticker or licence plate)
- Out of state permits OK
- Parent/Legal Guardian MUST be present at sign-up to sign for riders under 18.
- No Riders Insurance
- No Practice or Pre-Riding the course
- No spectators allowed on the course
- Same Day Trophies & Finisher Pins
- Extra gas MUST be in a D.O.T approved container
- Spectators Witness these events Assume All Risk of Injury And/ Or damage resulting there form
- We Reserve the RIGHT to DENY entry to any person(s)
- NO PIT RIDING, PIT BIKES or
- UNLEASHED DOGS, and NO CRY BABIES!
- No Open pit fires & no water hook ups
- Cow Mountain will be closed for Day use, April 2nd, 3rd and 4th.
- Food and Beverage and t-shirts available on Race day.
- **All Bikes will have Mandatory Sound Testing.**

Directions To Scott's Creek

Access, south Cow Mountain OHV.

Take HWY 101 North Through Ukiah.
Take HWY 20 East (right)
Take HWY 29 South (right) to Lake Port.
Exit at Scott's Valley Road.
Turn WEST (right) on Scott's Valley Road.
Travel zero point four miles.
Turn LEFT on RIGGS Road
Travel Zero Point Eight Miles on RIGGS ROAD.
Turn RIGHT on Scott's Creek Road.
Two point Four miles to Scott's Creek Access.
LOOK FOR ORANGE MOOSE ARROWS GUIDING YOUR WAY.
