

District 36 Number Change Rules/Instructions:

If you want to change your District 36 Membership number, there is a \$10 number change fee for a three digit number; a \$25 number change fee for a double digit number; and a \$50 number change fee for a single digit number. All numbers will still come with a letter. (Cross Country racers must put the letter after their membership number on their three number plates.)

Sportsman C Class riders and ALL Youth riders (all mini's and pee wee's in any discipline) **can only have a three digit number**, Sportsman B Class riders can have three or two digit numbers and Sportsman A Class riders are the only ones eligible for a single digit number. For those who are about to be advanced to a higher class, number change requests cannot be accepted or processed until after the Event Steward has verified and forwarded the advancement information.

Requests for number changes must be made in writing and must be accompanied by the appropriate payment for the number change. You must be a current D36 member to request a number change. (New D36 members will get whatever number that the data base assigns them when their application is processed.)

Your number change request must include your complete name, address, telephone number(s), current D36 number, current Class (A, B or C) and a list of your first three choices of a new number. (Your class will be verified before your request is processed.) Checking for available numbers will not be done before the number change fee is received. There is no guarantee that the number you want is available and there is no guarantee which letter will come with your number.

Number change requests must be made in writing and mailed to D36 Memberships, PO Box 1165, Rancho Cordova, CA 95741-1165. They must be submitted a minimum of three weeks prior to the first race you wish to have your new number as your race number. (Number change requests will not be done by phone calls or emails.) Cross Country racers must have their transponder reprogrammed when they receive their new membership card and must put the new numbers/letter on their three number plates.

D36 Memberships will process your number change request and mail you your new D36 Membership card. If your preferred numbers were not available, the D36 Membership person will contact you or return your request and payment to you. Make sure that all information you submit is legible, or it cannot be processed. Requests without the appropriate payment will be returned unprocessed.
