It is with sadness that I must report, CONFIRMED, that Carnegie SVRA will be closed at the end of business on the 28th of December.

THIS IS A TEMPORARY CLOSURE AS HAS BEEN PREVIOUSLY EXPLAINED.

Every effort will be put forth by the OHV Division, as well as the OHV Community to rectify this situation as quickly as possible. The hangups will be the Government process of Public Meetings, which have time lines that are not the most efficient, as well as the Water Quality Control Board review of submitted documents.

I believe we should have the park open and operating by Spring, as long as no additional hiccups occur. See the OHMVRD website for a release posted tonight.
