

**Rider Registration.** In order to register for the Answer / MSR / Pro Taper Racer Contingency Program, racers must purchase one pant, jersey, and glove combo, for each class raced, from a single dealer, either locally or via mail order. Apparel must be **current model year (2011)** and from one product line. - Answer Synchron and MSR Axxis will not qualify. The rider must then mail their registration form and original (copy of original) receipt for the apparel purchased to:

**Rider Qualification.** In order to qualify for contingency points at the end of the series, racers must compete (and be wearing the qualifying gear) in no less than **60%** of the events in the series. Therefore, all registration forms must be postmarked no later than the date of the race representing the **40%** mark. In other words, a rider would be required to compete in no less than 6 races of a 10 race series or 7 of an 11 race series and their registration form would need to be received no later than the 4<sup>th</sup> race of that series. Riders will **not** earn points for races run UNTIL their qualifying registration form and receipt are received.

**Registration Incentive for the Rider.** Each rider that registers for the Answer / MSR / Pro Taper Racer Contingency Program will receive a coupon pack valued at approximately \$100. Coupons will be for discounts on brands distributed by Tucker Rocky and must be redeemed in person at a Tucker Rocky Dealer with a walk-in retail establishment. Additionally, each registered rider will be allowed a one-time order for up to \$200 in Answer, MSR, or Pro Taper casual wear at 40% off retail (max order total is \$200 after discount) This order will be processed directly between the rider and Tucker Rocky via an order form sent to the rider along with the program welcome pack.

**Limitations.** Riders must purchase **one set of gear, for each class, in each series** in order to qualify for contingency payout.

**Contingency Payout.** The Answer / MSR / Pro Taper Racer Contingency Program will pay points to registered riders finishing **1<sup>st</sup> thru 10<sup>th</sup>** place for each event in the District 36 Series. Points schedule is as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> – 20 points	6 <sup>th</sup> – 10 points
2 <sup>nd</sup> – 18 points	7 <sup>th</sup> – 8 points
3 <sup>rd</sup> – 16 points	8 <sup>th</sup> – 6 points
4 <sup>th</sup> – 14 points	9 <sup>th</sup> – 4 points
5 <sup>th</sup> – 12 points	10 <sup>th</sup> – 2 points

Points earned will be tallied at the end of the series and converted to “Race Bucks” at the rate of \$1 (retail) per point. Contingency certificates will be mailed to riders or given at the series banquet and must be redeemed in person at any Tucker Rocky Dealer for merchandise distributed by Tucker Rocky Distributing only. Riders on free product support contracts or discount sponsorship will not be eligible unless they follow all the guidelines for a non-sponsored rider. Payout is subject to promoter limitations or restrictions.
