**Committee Reports:**

***Sanctioning:*** Steward Jeff Henning not in attendance.

- The 2010 Annual Sanction Meeting will be held on December 11, 2010 – doors open at 8:00AM. The address is American Legion Hall, 320 N. Washington St, Lodi, CA 95240.
- Dirt Track Planning meeting November 20, 2010. Location Tio Pepes 135 E. Lindsey St in Stockton at 9:00AM. Reminder: all clubs/promoters are required to have two representatives present at this meeting; one is required to be the event Referee.

***Youth Cross Country:*** Steward Al Fitch reported:

- October 23, 2010: Deer Creek GP hosted by NorCal MC. There were 9 C 50s, 16 AB 50s, 72 C Youth and 24 AB Youth for a total of 125 youth riders.
- October 31, 2010: Honeylake hosted by E Street MX. There were 6 C 50s, 14 AB 50s, 21 AB Kids and 53 C Youth for a total of 94 youth riders.
- November 6, 2010: Lilliputian National HS hosted by Dirt Diggers North MC. There were 12 AB 50s, 16 C 50s, 104 C Youth, 24 AB Youth for a total of 174 youth riders.
- November 14, 2010: Oasis HS hosted by Cross Country Promotions. There were 13 C 50s, 18 AB 50s, 65 C Kids and 21 AB Kids for a total of 121 youth riders.
- Youth rider Alex Forwerck #445G passed away Friday night after being hit by a car. Our sincere condolences go out to the family and friends of Alex.

***Cross Country:*** Steward Kraig Traum reported:

- October 24, 2010: Deer Creek hosted by NorCal MC. There were 5 AA, 59 A, 88 B, 96 C, 6 Jr Sportsmen and 5 Vintage blue plate for a total of 259 adult riders. Conditions were dry on Saturday and wet to muddy on Sunday. The club was great to work with, parking/camping was great, they had food being cooked all day and a great band playing Saturday night. A lot of comments from riders: “best club to deal with, real friendly and helpful.” Course was up and down hills, single track and off cambers. Turn out was very light.
- October 30, 2010: Honeylake hosted by E Street MX. Conditions were dry, dusty and very windy. Turn out was very light. There were 11 AA, 56 A, 72 B 84 C, 2 Jr sportsmen and 3 vintage blue plate for a total of 229 adult racers.
- November 7, 2010: Lilliputian National HS hosted by Dirt Diggers. There were 12 AA, 65 A, 91 B, 77 C Sportsmen and Vet, 95 C Seniors, 20 JR Sportsmen and 4 Vintage BP for a total of 364 adult class riders.

- November 13, 2010: Oasis Fall HS hosted by CCP. Conditions were good with a lot of windy. Very low turn out. There were 10 AA, 57 A, 68 B, 40 C Sportsmen, 58 C Vets +, 7 Jr sportsmen and 4 Vintage BP for a total of 244 adult class riders.

Meeting called to order at 9:03 p.m. by Director Jeff Irwin

Roll Call: 24 of 64 Members in Attendance

Wayne Halozan: Notice that sound test is required at the Prairie City GP. Rangers requirement: Top three riders from each event will be sound tested.

Rule Proposal #2010-13 submitted by John Davis. Exact rule as proposed: Add District 36 membership MUST be current at the time of event worked to rules 7.5.3, 7.5.4, 7.6.3, 7.6.3.1. Motion to accept the rule proposal. Vote 9-2, motion passed. Proposal accepted.

Rule Proposal #2010-16 submitted by Jeff Irwin. Exact rule as proposed: *10.1.2 Types of Events: An Amateur event is any competitive event where speed and/or skill of the rider determines the winner. Events shall include, but are not limited to, the following categories:*

- A. *Cross Country*
- B. *Enduro*
- C. *Motorcross*
- D. *Scrambles*
- E. *Dirt Track*
- F. *Supermoto*
- G. *Special Events.*

*For the race types includes in each of the above categories, see the appropriate rules sections. Qualifiers (Reliability Trials) are administered by the Enduro Steward, but also pay Cross Country points. Cross Country riders should review the Enduro section.* Motion to accept the rule proposal. Vote 19-2, 1 abstain. Motion carried – rule proposal accepted.

Rule Proposal #2010-17 submitted by Jeff Irwin. Exact rule as proposed: *Delete rule 7.6.9.1.* Motion to accept the rule proposal. Vote 22-0. Motion carried, rule proposal accepted.

Rule Proposal #2010-18 submitted by Jeff Irwin. Exact rule as proposed: *8.3 The Referee of the sponsoring organization shall wear a black and white striped shirt or jacket during the meet. He shall be the only one so attired. 8.5 At the rider's meeting the Referee is responsible to explain any special event procedures, rules and conditions, and to answer all questions regarding the meet.* Motion to accept the rule proposal. Vote 19-0. Motion carried, proposal accepted.

Rule Proposal #2010-19 submitted by Jeff Irwin. Exact rule as proposed: *11.1.4 All cross country courses must be marked with arrows, lime or ribbons. Three arrows pointing down must be used to indicate an area that requires a high level of skill. An arrow will be placed 30 to 50 feet prior to a direction change and two arrows at the point of change. Wrong way markers will also be used. The rider must stay within 20 feet of the marked course.* Motion to accept the proposal. Vote 18-2, 2 abstain. Motion carried. Proposal accepted.

Rule Proposal #2010-20 submitted by Jeff Irwin. Exact rule as proposed: *6.11 In Dirt Track events, oil drain plugs shall be safety-wired.* Motion to accept rule as proposed. Vote 21-0, 1 abstain. Motion carried.

Rule Proposal #2010-21 submitted by Jeff Irwin. Exact rule as proposed: *6.7.1 Sound tests may be administered at any time during the meet.* Motion to accept rule as proposed. Vote 22-0. Motion carried.

Rule Proposal #2010-22 submitted by Jeff Irwin. Exact rule as proposed: *7.2.1 A, B, and C Classes: One trophy for the class and one for each five riders or major portion thereof after the first 5 riders in that class, but not to exceed 10 trophies per class.* Proposal tabled at the submitters request.
